INTERNATIONAL BALLOON FESTIVAL

Every January, the Alpine hot air ballooning capital, the village of Château-d'Œx in the region of Pays-d'Enhaut, welcomes hot air balloons from all over the world.

For more than 40 years, the Festival has brought together balloonists from some twenty countries. Nearly a hundred hot air balloon pilots come to enjoy the exceptional winter climate of the Alps.

Discover balloons with unusual colours and shapes! Hot air balloons, specially shaped balloons, and other flying machines fill the nine days of the Festival. Tethered flights and air shows are also on the programme, all you need to enjoy the magical atmosphere with friends or family.

The link between Château-d'Œx and hot air balloons is written in history. In 1999, the Breitling Orbiter - piloted by Bertrand Piccard and Brian Jones - took off from Château-d'Œx for the first round-the-world balloon trip. Learn more about the history of this crazy adventure at the "Espace Ballon" in Château-d'Œx.

In order to fully experience the Festival, balloon flights are carried out every day, subject to weather conditions. Sit comfortably in the balloon basket and take off for about an hour's flight into the snowy landscapes of the Pays-d'Enhaut region.



Straps

The horizontal and vertical straps reinforce the double stitching (like the seams of a pair of jeans).

Valve

PAYS-D'ENHA

CHÂTEAU-D'ŒX | ROUGEMONT | ROSSINIÈRE

a nylon disc located inside the balloon that closes the opening of the envelope. Under the pressure of the hot air, the disc presses against the orifice. The pilot uses a cord connected to a pulley that hangs down to the basket to empty or remove part of the air in the balloon. This manoeuvre is used during landing.

Colours

Specially treated, these magnificent colours protect and ensure the envelope's airtightness.

Tissu

Il est en nylon très léger (35 à 55g /m2). Le tissage est renforcé par des fils très solides, espacés de quelques millimètres, empêchant des déchirures.

Envelope

Made up of vertical strips which are made up of a series of panels.

Burner

The burner is powered by pressurised liquid propane gas held in gas cylinders weighing 20 to 40 kg. Single to quadruple burners are suspended in the pivoting burner frame. In the upper part, the gas circulates in spiral-shaped tubes. This increases the pressure of the propane under the effect of heat. Finally, it escapes at high pressure at the nozzles and ignites when it comes into contact with the pilot flame.

Envelope base

The base is made of Nomex, which is even more heat resistant than nylon and is non-flammable.

It's the same kind of fabric used for Formula 1 drivers' suits.

Basket

It is a wicker basket connected to the envelope by cables passing under the floor of the basket. Wicker, in addition to its aesthetic qualities, is a light, flexible and resistant material.

Balloon flights as well as helicopter flights are possible every day of the festival! Take a seat in the gondola and share this unique moment through your media.

Drones

For safety reasons, special zones for drone flights are designated around the take-off field. Once the flight is approved by the organization, fly alongside the hot air balloons!



A BIT OF HISTORY

February 1979, the Tourist Office, in collaboration with Hans Bücker, organizes the 1st International Hot Air Balloon Week, with the participation of 12 balloons from 5 countries. This original activity helps promote Château-d'Œx in Switzerland and abroad. David Niven, the famous actor from «Around the World in 80 Days,» is the patron of this 1st edition.

February 1994, 4th World Championship of Hot Air Airships. It is the first time such an event takes place in Switzerland, in the mountains, and in winter. 16 pilots from 9 countries compete in 12 events spread throughout the Pays-d'Enhaut. Julia Kourotchkina, Miss World 1993, and Roger Moore, alias «James Bond,» are the godmother and godfather of this edition.

March 1999, the Breitling Orbiter III of Bertrand Piccard and Brian Jones takes off from Château-d'Œx on March 1 at 9:05 am. After 19 days, 21 hours, and 47 minutes of flight, it lands on March 21 at 6:57 am in the Egyptian desert. This is the first balloon around-the-world tour, and duration and flight distance records (45,755 km) are broken.

2010: The 32nd edition suffers from gloomy weather conditions. For the first time, the Night Glow has to be canceled. On the positive side, the program has expanded to include other flying devices. Also noteworthy is the magnificent flight celebrating the 10th anniversary of the twinning of the cities of Bristol (GB), Romorantin (FR), Sint-Niklaas (BE), and Château-d'Œx.

2017: From the opening to the closure of the event, all possible flight windows are exploited. Pilots accumulate over 800 hours of flights for 611 take-offs. There is also the launch of the gas balloon piloted by Nicolas Tièche and Laurent Sciboz, who, after 21 hours in the air, land in the French Jura. After 5 years of absence, the Night Glow offers a unique spectacle and constitutes the climax of the event.

2023: This year marks the 43rd edition of the International Balloon Festival after 2 years of absence due to the pandemic! During the 9 days of the festival, 8 days allowed for take-offs and balloon flights, mainly in the mornings. In total, the 60 balloons were able to take off 379 times from Château-d'Œx, totaling 498 hours of flight during the festival.
